BYLAW NO. 348

‘SCHEDULE A’

Rates and Charges chargeable by the Regional District for the disposal of NON-GARBAGE items. Garbage is to be sorted prior to deposit. Garbage not sorted is prohibited from being deposited at the landfill.

- Sort Categories:**
- 1) Burn Pile – segregated and clean woody material, paper and cardboard ONLY
 - 2) Metals
 - 3) Household Garbage
 - 4) Tires

A PERMIT TO DISPOSE OF NON-GARBAGE ITEMS SHALL BE OBTAINED FROM THE CENTRAL COAST REGIONAL DISTRICT DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS.

SORTED NON-GARBAGE DUMPING RATE (see definitions below):

NON-GARBAGE ITEMS SHALL MEAN AND INCLUDE:

Motor vehicle parts (BATTERIES ARE PROHIBITED) and bodies, machinery parts, household appliances, household furniture, office machines and furniture, building materials of a non-combustible nature (*plastics, treated wood, etc.*), plastics, metals, wheelbarrows, fishing nets, tarps, fencing materials, stumps, trees, and brush. Large items such as bunkhouses, trailers, boats, or items of equivalent size, and materials deemed to be contaminated, shall be discussed with the regional district office prior to disposal.

CATEGORY DEFINITIONS

Categories A, B and C shall be based on ½ ton or ¾ ton pick-up.

Utility trailer sizes shall be based on ½ ton or ¾ ton pick-up.

Trailers attached to larger trucks to be based on and priced according to that truck’s size.

- A - Single Item/ Small Load:** Equivalent to ¼ pick-up load.
B – Half Load: Equivalent to ½ pick-up load.
C – Full Load: Equivalent to full pick-up load
D – Mid-Size Load: Equivalent to 1 – 3 ton single axle truck (includes 8 ft flatbed)
E – Large Load: Equivalent to over 3 ton to 5 ton single axle truck (includes 12 ft flatbed)
F – Oversize Load: Equivalent to tandem axle gravel trucks, low-beds.
G – Other: Anything other than the above such as bunkhouses, trailers, boats, items deemed to be contaminated, etc.

Any vehicle or utility trailer with extensions on the box shall be charged the next highest rate.
