



REGIONAL DISTRICT OF MOUNT WADDINGTON BYLAW NO. 787

A bylaw to provide for the control, collection and disposal of garbage and recyclables generated in the community of Malcolm Island

WHEREAS the *Local Government Act* empowers a regional district to operate any service that its Board considers necessary or desirable for all or part of the regional district;

AND WHEREAS the Board of the Regional District of Mount Waddington wishes to establish a service for the purpose of providing waste management on Malcolm Island;

AND WHEREAS Pursuant to sections 24(5)(7) of the Environmental Management Act, the Minister of Environment has approved an amendment to the Regional District of Mount Waddington's Solid Waste Management Plan to include the Malcolm Island Solid Waste Management Plan;

AND WHEREAS the Director of Electoral Area "A" has consented to the establishment of the service area;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Regional District of Mount Waddington in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. **Service**

The Regional District of Mount Waddington hereby establishes a service area to provide solid waste and recycling collection and transfer station services on Malcolm Island, to be known as the "Malcolm Island Waste Management Service Area" (the "**Service**").

2. **Boundary**

The boundary of the Service Area is shown outlined on Schedule "A" (the "**Service Area**") attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.

3. **Participating Areas**

The "**Participating Area**" for the **Service** is that portion of Electoral Area "A" shown on Schedule "A" as the **Service Area** referred to in the preceding section 2 of this bylaw.

4. **Cost Recovery**

The annual costs of providing the service shall be recovered by one or more of the following:

- a. The imposition of fees and charges that may be fixed by separate bylaw for the purpose of recovering these costs;
- b. The imposition of a property value tax; and
- c. Revenues received by way of agreement, enterprise, gift, grant or otherwise.

5. **Maximum Requisition**

The maximum annual amount that may be requisitioned for the **Service** is \$1,000.

6. **Powers**

To operate this service, the Regional District may:

- a) Acquire land and/or equipment necessary to provide a waste management collection, recycling and transfer system;
- b) enter into service agreements for the provision and maintenance of the service;
- c) by bylaw, establish an Advisory Committee for the purpose of providing advice with respect to operation of the service;

7. **Effective Dates**

This Bylaw takes effect November 1, 2010.

8. **Citation**

This bylaw may be cited as the "Regional District of Mount Waddington Malcolm Island Waste Management Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 787, 2010".

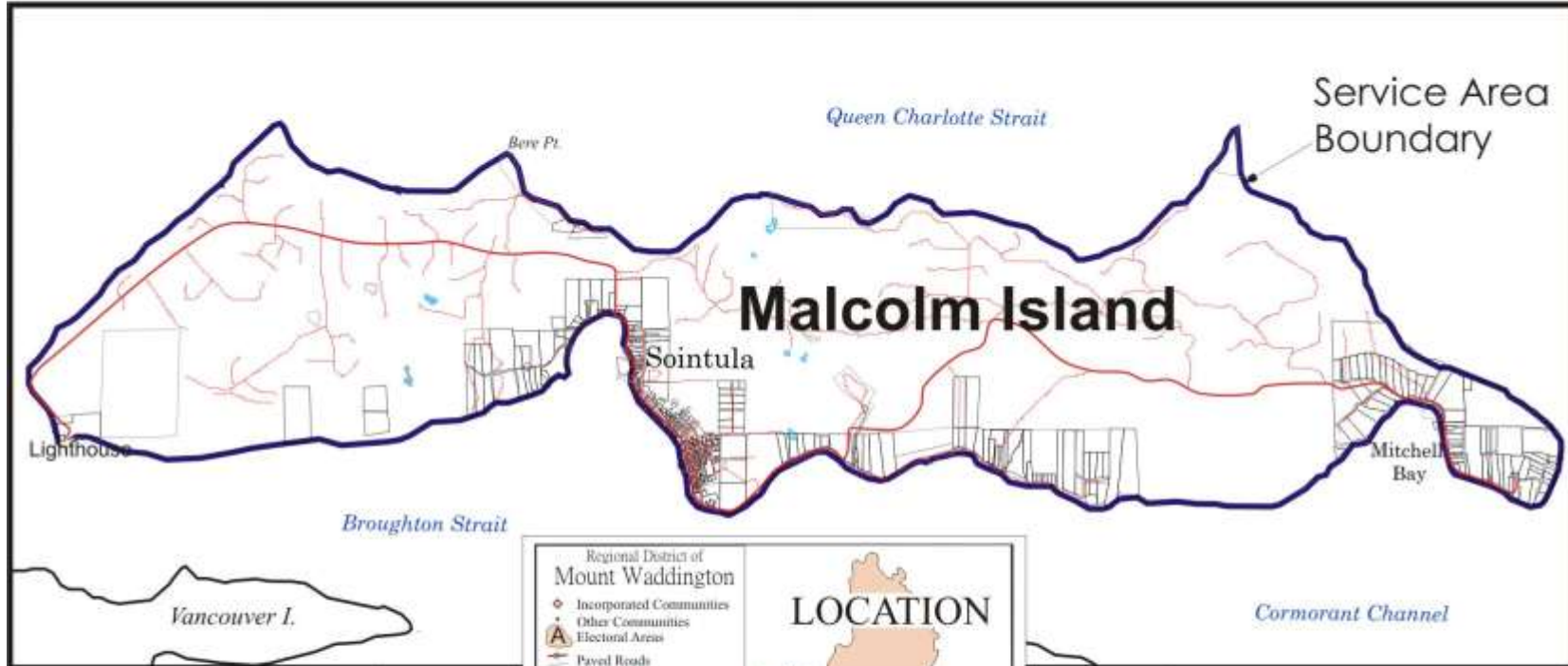
