

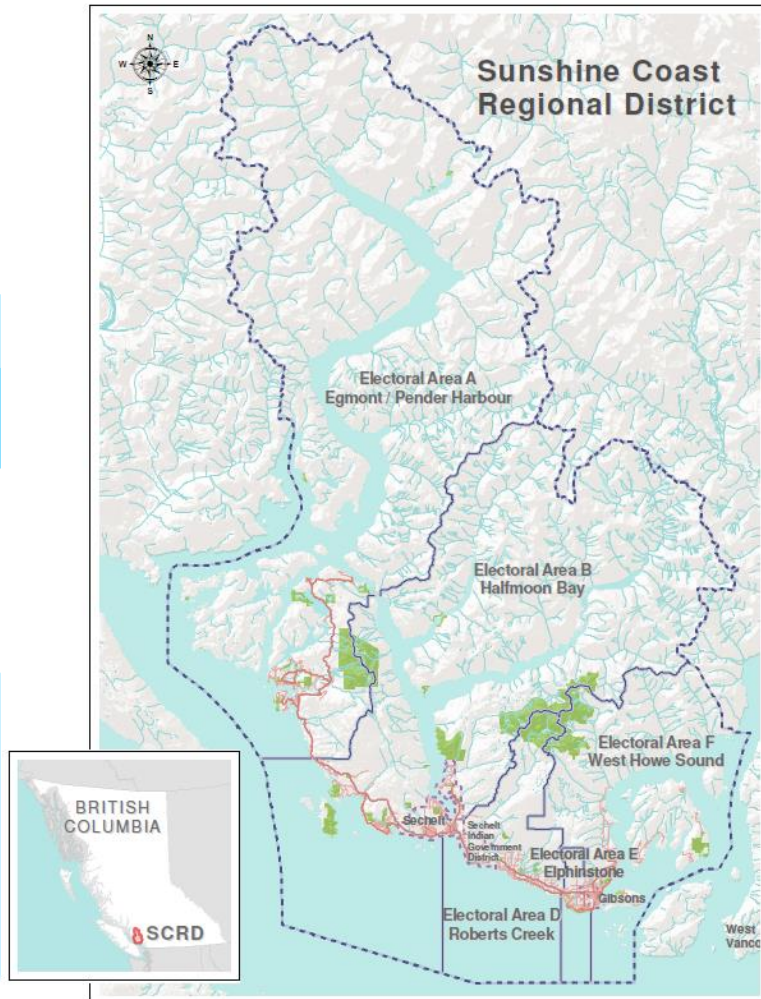

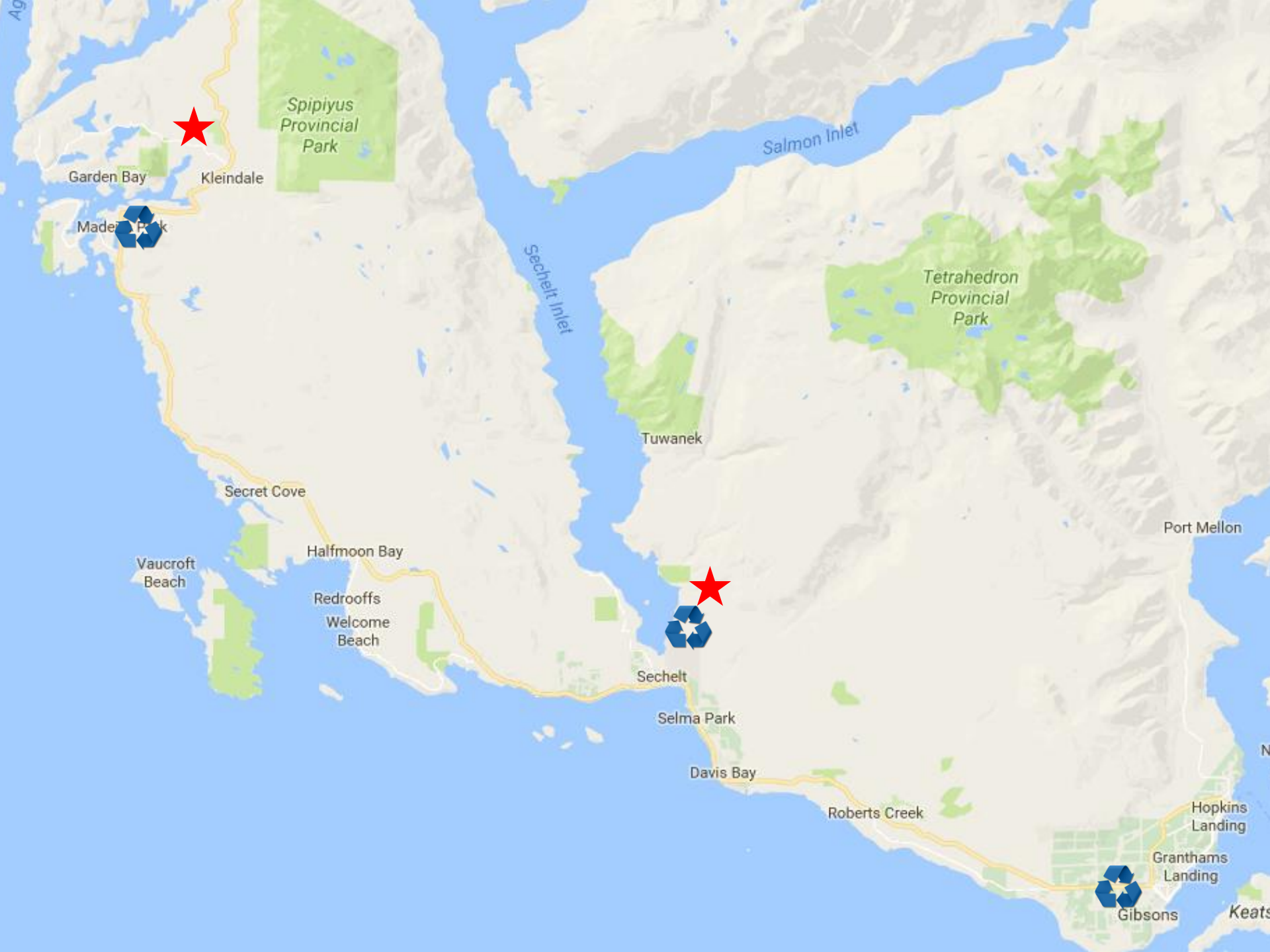


Sunshine Coast Regional District

Local Context & Challenges

- Few contractors, minimal competition
- Influenced by seasonal residents and visitors
- Increase in residents from Lower Mainland
- Landfill & Transfer Station subject to market conditions
 - Many materials require delivery off-coast for processing
 - Good economy = increased tonnage received
 - Commodity prices for revenue of recyclables (metal) fluctuate

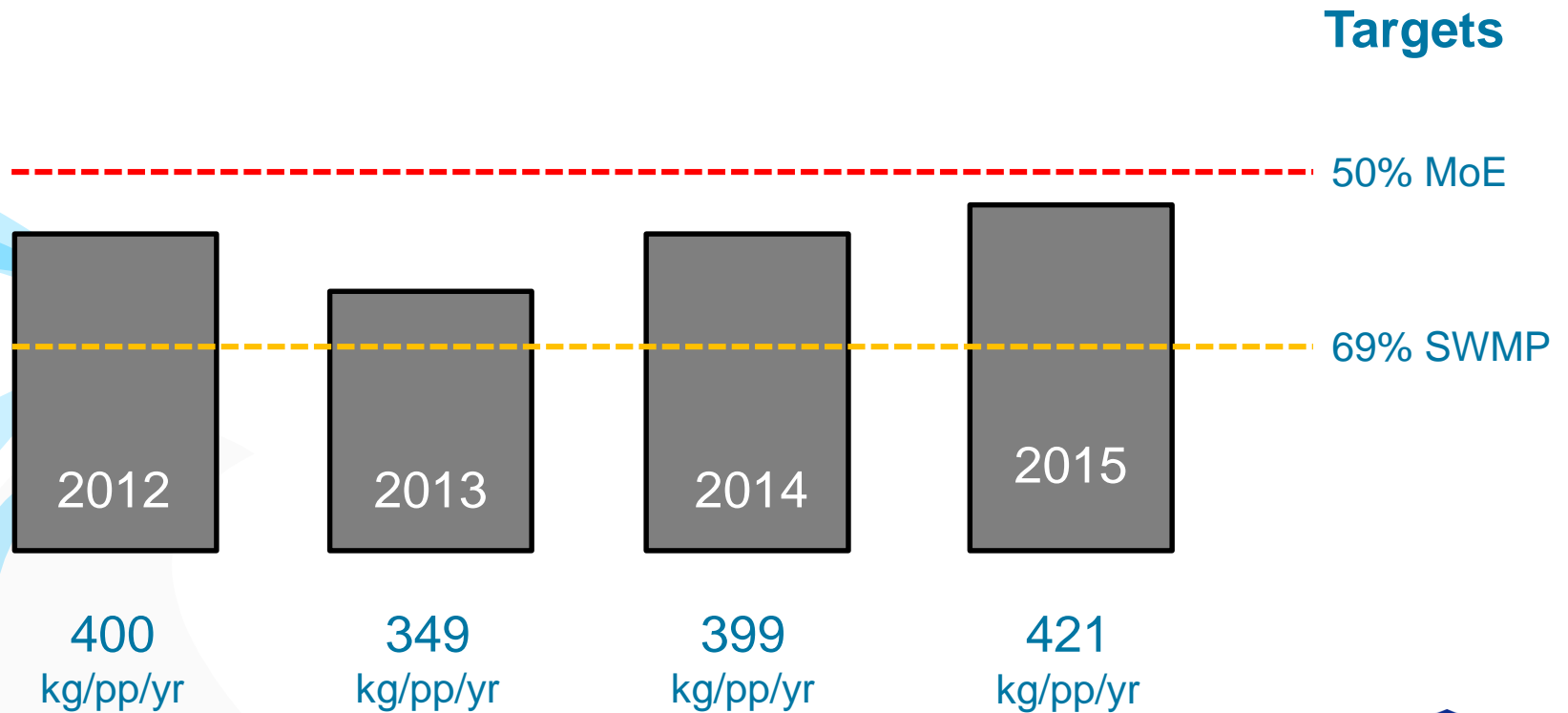


Local Context & Challenges

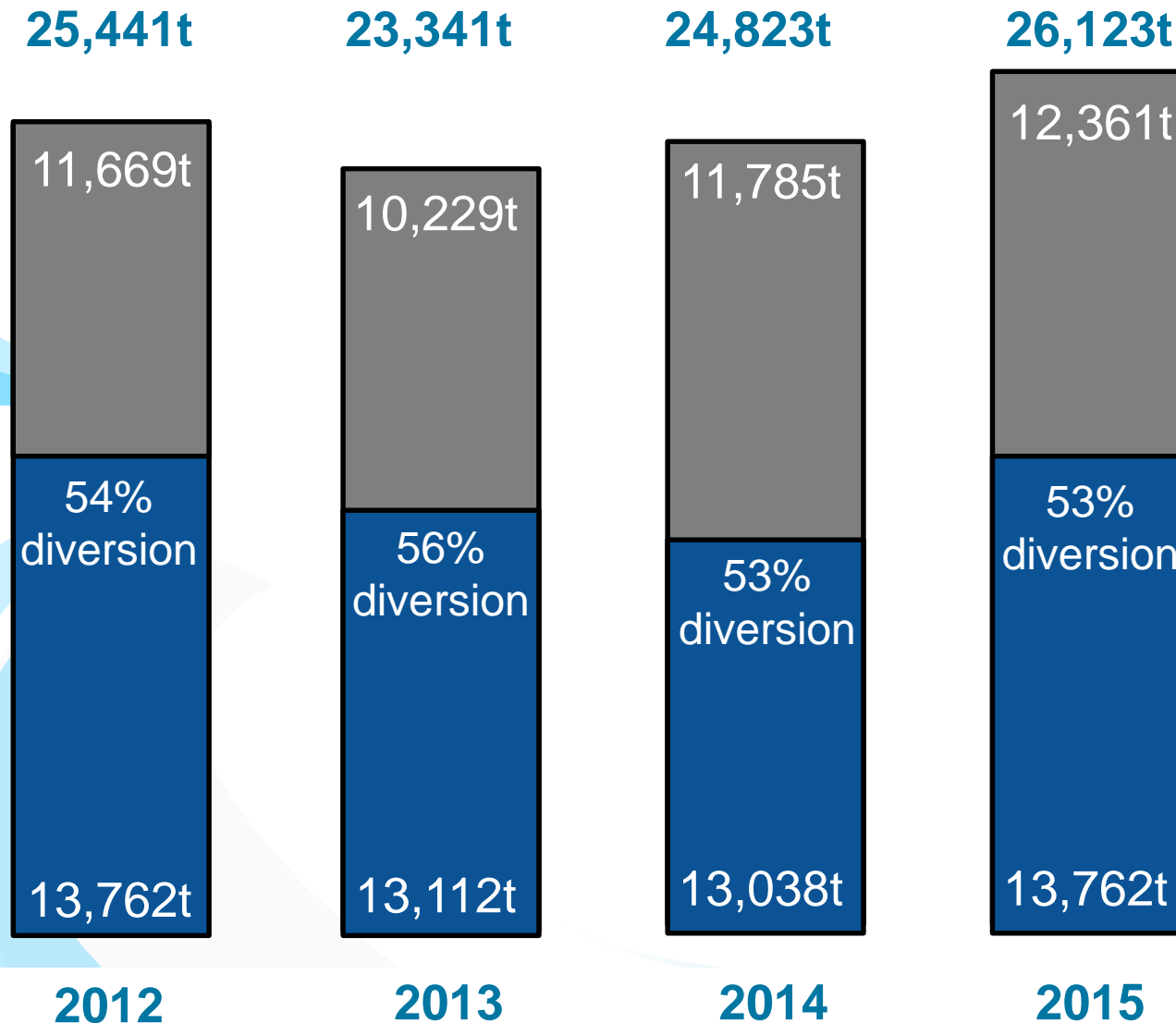
- Depot-only service for recycling, residents must deliver to sites; SCRCD contracts to 3 depot operators for Recycle BC materials
- Limited or no recycling option on Coast for household hazardous materials e.g. oil, anti-freeze, chemicals
- Sechelt Landfill 10-15 years capacity remaining
